

Directions to Thorpe Farm Bunkhouses

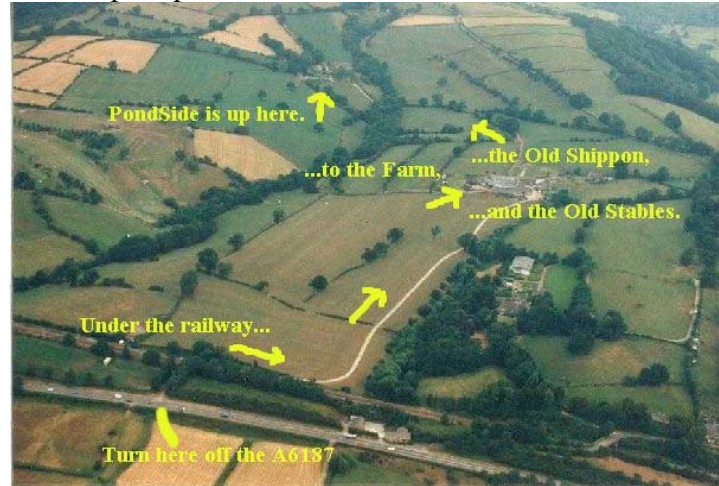
Thorpe Farm OS Grid Reference: SK 223 824

For best results use the instructions below in conjunction with a road atlas or Ordnance Survey map (Landranger 119).

Please note that the trunk roads have been renumbered in this region : THE A625 IN THIS AREA HAS BECOME THE A6187.

From the South via the M1

1. Leave at Junction 29, sign posted Chesterfield and Chatsworth. Head west towards Chesterfield (A617).
2. At Chesterfield head for Baslow and Chatsworth (A619).
3. From Baslow roundabout follow A623 to Calver Crossroads [traffic lights]. At traffic lights turn right towards Grindleford/Hathersage (B6001).
4. In Grindleford turn left up steep hill towards Hathersage (B6001).
5. At the T-junction in Hathersage (opposite the George Hotel) turn left towards Castleton (A6187, formerly A625).
6. $\frac{3}{4}$ mile out of Hathersage, just past the large B&B at Hill Foot, turn right up our private drive sign posted Thorpe Farm Bunkhouses.
7. Go under the railway line and follow the drive to the right up to Thorpe Farm.

From Sheffield

1. Follow A625 towards Castleton.
2. Towards Fox House the A625 'becomes' the A6187 to Hathersage and Castleton.
3. At Hathersage carry straight on towards Castleton.
4. $\frac{3}{4}$ mile out of Hathersage, just past the large B&B at Hill Foot, turn right up our private drive sign posted Thorpe Farm Bunkhouses.
5. Go under the railway line and follow the drive to the right up to Thorpe Farm.

From the A57 (Sheffield to Manchester road, "Snake Pass")

1. Take the A6013 over Ladybower Reservoir.
2. Carry on through Bamford.
3. At the T-junction turn left on to the A6187 (formerly the A625).
4. Continue for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile. We are the second private drive on the left, sign posted Thorpe Farm Bunkhouses.
5. Go under the railway line and follow the drive to the right up to Thorpe Farm.

From the West

1. Leave Chapel-en-le-Frith on the A623
2. EITHER:
 - Turn left at the Wanted Inn in Sparrowpit, sign posted Castleton, carry on for 6 miles, skip to step 5 (only use in good weather conditions), or
 - Continue on the A623 to Tideswell Crossroads.
3. Turn left and follow B6049 through Bradwell and Brough.
4. At the T-junction (opposite the Travellers Rest) turn right on the A6187 (formerly the A625).
5. Continue for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile past the traffic lights. We are the second private drive on the left, sign posted Thorpe Farm Bunkhouses.
6. Go under the railway line and follow the drive to the right up to Thorpe Farm.
